Youth Basketball Rules

The City of Aurora will follow the Missouri State High School Athletic Association rules with a few exceptions as follows:

1. Basketball size: K-2nd junior
 3rd-6th intermediate (women's)
2. Goal height: k-2nd 8 '
 3rd-6th 10 '
3. Free throw distance: K-4th 10 '
 5th-6th 15 '
4. Games will consist of two (2) 15-minute halves, a three (3) minute half time and 5 minutes between each game. Half time and time between games can be shortened if we are running behind schedule.
5. Each team will receive two time-outs per half with no carry over.
6. Clock runs continuously during the game until the last sixty (60) seconds of the second half only.
7. Three-second violations will be called on 5th and 6th grade teams only.
8. Full court press is allowed only when a team is less than 20 points ahead. K-1 is restricted to playing half court press. 2nd and 3rd grades are restricted to half court press until the last two minutes of the game, at which full court press can take effect.
9. Tie games will be decided as follows:
 Two minute overtime period will be allowed with a continuous running clock.
 Each team receives one time-out. If neither team is ahead at end of period the game is a tie.
10. No more than 20 points will be shown on the scoreboard but the score will be kept in the scorebook. K-1 will have no score kept; only fouls and time will be recorded.
11. Teams found playing with players who are on another roster will forfeit the game, unless the team is in another division.
12. All forms must be filled out entirely before the season begins. Players must be at least 5 years old on August 1st to participate.
13. No players will be allowed to transfer teams.
14. All teams must have a minimum of 6 players on a team.

15. Players may play in both the recreational and competitive divisions.
16. Players must have on same color shirts with numbers on their backs for identification purposes.
17. All team members are required to play at least 8 minutes of each game or the coach will forfeit that game.
18. The scorebook is the official record and all teams are encouraged to keep their own scorebook.
19. No grace period is allowed for any game.
20. Team must contact Recreation Coordinator to forfeit.
21. No protests are allowed on judgment calls. All complaints must be directed to the Recreation Coordinator.
22. All teams must show good sportsman-like conduct by lining up and shaking hands after every game.
23. Referees, Game Supervisors or the Recreation Coordinator reserve the right to eject any person from the game that threatens the integrity of the sport, facility or the league.
24. There is not a max amount of players allowed per team but each player is required to play at least 8 minutes of each game.
