

RESOLUTION 2021-1803

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SEWER CAMERA INSPECTION SYSTEM TO BE USED IN THE CITY OF AURORA WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY

WHEREAS, it has been requested and approved by Council in the 2021 budget for the purchase of a sewer camera inspection system for the Wastewater Department; and

WHEREAS, the Wastewater Treatment Facility Superintendent has received a quote from Midwest Vac Products that meets or exceeds the state bid requirements in accordance City of Aurora City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 135, Section 135.110: State Bids – Cooperative Procurement Plans; and

WHEREAS, Midwest Vac Products is contracted with Sourcewell, formerly NJPA, for their cooperative bidding process; and

WHEREAS, Midwest Vac Products, 7627 Richter Road, Mascoutah, IL 62258 has offered the City of Aurora the purchase of a sewer camera inspection system at the cost of \$77,870.38; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Midwest Vac Products, 7627 Richter Road, Mascoutah, IL 62258 for the purchase of a sewer camera inspection system in the amount of \$77,870.38.
