

RESOLUTION 2022-1841

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF BROADBAND INFRASTRUCTURE AND SERVICE CONTRACT FOR BROADBAND SERVICES TO CITY FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has solicited bids for the construction and installation of broadband infrastructure and broadband services from available vendors serving the Aurora area; and

WHEREAS, City Staff followed the bid procedures in accordance with City of Aurora City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 135, Section 135.130: Sole-Source and Monopoly Purchases, Section 4, the installation of Broadband infrastructure combined with broadband services requires specific circumstances requiring specialized consultants and technical services that require specialized abilities and expertise; and

WHEREAS, the Master Service Agreement and the Service Description has been reviewed by the City Attorney and has been recommended for approval; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the proposed project will be derived from funds received by the City of Aurora under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 in accordance with guidelines set forth by the United States Dept. of Treasury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Missouri Telecom in the amount of \$29,400 for the installation of broadband infrastructure and the subsequent service of broadband high-speed internet services to City facilities.
