

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-1860

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI ESTABLISHING
GUIDELINES FOR COMMUNITY GARDENS**

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora, Missouri (the "City"), is a city of the third class and political subdivision of the State of Missouri, duly created, organized, and existing under and by the virtue of the constitution and laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora, Missouri has chosen to partner with non-profit organizations and local groups in addressing food insecurity through the creation of community gardens as a means to relieve hunger, improve nutrition, and increase access to and distribution of food for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora, Missouri has determined that community gardens will have a positive impact on the community by providing opportunities for education of students and individuals actively participating in local groups or schools; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish guidelines for the operation of community gardens on City owned land other than City parks; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Aurora, Lawrence County, Missouri,

Section 1: The City of Aurora City Council adopts the following guidelines for community gardens as outlined in the document titled "Operational Guidelines for Community Gardens on City Land Other Than City Parks"
