

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-1931

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN ALEXIS MINI PUMPER TO REPLACE UNIT 2311 ENGINE TO BE USED IN THE CITY OF AURORA FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora, Missouri (the "City"), is a city of the third class and political subdivision of the State of Missouri, duly created, organized and existing under and by virtue of the constitution of the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, in accordance City of Aurora City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 135, Section 135.110: State Bids – Cooperative Procurement Plans, staff has received a state bid for an Alexis Mini Pumper in the amount of \$358,859.00 through HGAC (Helping Governments Across the County Buy); and

WHEREAS, the cost of the Ford F550 chassis in the amount of \$70,702.00 must accompany the order and signed contract to begin the order; and

WHEREAS, the remaining \$288,157.00 will be financed prior to delivery of the equipment using local financial institutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Alexis for the purchase and delivery of an Alexis Mini Pumper in the amount of \$358,859.00.

Section 2. Unit 2311 is a 1982 Chevrolet Kodiak Engine that will be disposed of per the procurement policy. It has not passed pump testing for the past three years and does not meet the current safety standards as set forth in current NFPA 1901, Standard for Automotive Fire Apparatus.

Section 3. The 2023 budget shall be amended in the amount of \$70,702.00 for the initial outlay.
