

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI, AMENDING CHAPTER 335 "STOP AND YIELD INTERSECTIONS, RAILROAD CROSSINGS" SCHEDULE II, STOP SIGNS, TABLE II-A STOP SIGNS-GENERALLY, LOCATION.

WHEREAS, The City of Aurora, Missouri (the "City"), is a City of the third class and a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, duly created, organized and existing under and by the virtue of the constitution and laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, The Chief of Police and the Street Superintendent are authorized to implement Emergency and Experimental traffic ordinances under Aurora City Code 305.040 for up to ninety (90) days; and

WHEREAS, A stop sign has been installed at the intersection of W. Minor and Cowan Streets at the request of citizens who live in the immediate area; and

WHEREAS, The installation of the stop sign has had the intended effect of slowing down traffic and making the intersection of W. Minor and Cowan Street safer; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the Street Superintendent and the Chief of Police that this stop sign be made permanent and the Aurora City Code so shall reflect that change.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

That Chapter 335 "Stop and Yield Intersections, Railroad Crossings" Schedule II, Stop Signs, Table II-A, Stop Signs-Generally, Stop Sign Location, will hereby be amended by adding the following stop sign to the Schedule II list:

Stop Sign: Minor, Westbound at Cowan
