

RESOLUTION 2021-1780

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A WORK AGREEMENT WITH ALLGEIER MARTIN AND ASSOCIATES FOR THE PLANNING AND DESIGN OF THE WHITE PARK-CROSBY PARK-AURORA SCHOOLS TRAILS LINK

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora City Council has an interest in working toward a recreational trails system that runs throughout the Aurora community that links all City Parks and Aurora R-8 School District schools that provides recreational opportunities and transportation alternatives to the community; and

WHEREAS, Allgeier Martin and Associates is the city engineering firm; and

WHEREAS, Allgeier Martin and Associates has submitted a suitable scope of work authorization for the planning and design of a White Park-Crosby Park-Aurora Schools Trail Link Project in the amount \$114,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Allgeier Martin and Associates for the planning and design of White Park-Crosby Park-Aurora Schools Trails Link in the amount of \$114,000.
