SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of engineering services in this agreement covers engineering coordination and on-site observation of the replacement of sewer lines and installation of manholes in Basins 4A and 4H. Engineering services will include preparation of plans and specifications for the project as well as bidding and construction phase services. Plans and specifications will be prepared in accordance with MDNR standards and a construction permit will be obtained, if required. Bidding services will include assisting the City in advertising for bids, reviewing bids submitted, and award of the contract to the selected bidder. Construction phase services will also include the review of material submittals and coordination with the City and Contractor to assist in answering questions throughout construction. The scope also includes up to 20 days of on-site observation of project progress, including a statement of work completed, if needed.
